Oct. 5: is reserved for a visit Old Town, San Diego, while the afternoon plans include a visit to San Diego State University, especially the Newman Center, and Mission San Diego de Alcalá, followed by a tour of the House of Formation and the Blessed Sacrament Parish grounds, concluding with dinner at the parish's October Fest.

Oct. 6: the schedule includes Mass at St. James or St. Leo's, a Mexican lunch, an afternoon tour of San Diego with a dinner cruise on San Diego Bay, which marks the end of the Congress, though some of the guests may choose to use Monday for visits to the San Diego Zoo, Wild Animal Park, or Sea World.

Three days before the above schedule, the Provincial Council of Eudist priests will gather for meetings at Kolbe Hall at the University of San Diego campus.

Accomplishments Surge at Center

The St. John Eudes Center in Buffalo, New York, has accomplished a great deal in recent years. Over 22,000 Catholics attended parish missions and over 13,000 attended various workshops sponsored by the Center in 60 parishes and over 32 dioceses between 1999 and 2001.
